Check In

Send an SMS with "para start so" (without quotes) to the CCSS number in order to register with the CCSS (Cross Country Safety System).

Report Back

Send an SMS with "para stop" (without quotes) to the CCSS number. Report back has to be done within 15 minutes after landing!

You will get an automatic confirmation message after we received your mes-

sage. You have to send the SMS also if you decided not to fly. You can add additional information after "para stop" to the message. For example you could send "para stop Landed in Fiesch".

Retrieve

If you do not land at Fiesch you can take the MGB train (red trains) for free. Only for the return journey to Fiesch, with paragliding equipment and only on days when a task is started.

You have to show your Competition-ID-Card.

If you land further than Visp, you have to take the trains from SBB. It is important to buy the SBB-ticket to Brig by your own! At Brig you will change the train to MGB, witch is covered with your Competition-ID-Card. You can get a refund for the ticket you have bought at the headquarter (pls. show your ticket).

Airports

Sion: There will be no tasks set with turnpoints north of Sion airport on days when the TMA is active. On all other days: Stay clear of the CTR and TMA1 (see turnpoint map).

Münster/Raron: Airfield must be crossed with a minimum altitude of 1950/1150 m MSL. Landing inside the red airfield zone is forbidden.

Maximum altitude

As the airspace permits.
