No entry fee will be refunded after the registration deadline. Exceptions will be decided by the organiser and the event organiser.

LAUNCH SYSTEM

There will be 1-2 Lanes available per launch site. The order will be made by the judges based on the placing during the competition and is controlled by the take-off marshal. The pilots must line up fully ready to take-off and the take-off marshal will do the last safety check prior to take-off.
