Helicopter Rescue

- Download the REGA-App (Swiss phone numbers only).
- Download for other phone Numbers (<https://apktada.com/app/ch.rega.Reg>)

Serious accident

- Call the Rega directly

"Normal" accidents:

- Call the safety number. We will act accordingly and call the REGA if you are safe.

Tree landings and rescue:

- Call us! We have professional tree operators and we will inform the REGA about the incident.

Radio frequency (PMR)

- Normally 7-38
To enter manually:
446.08125 / 250.3 rt-cdc
- 2-m-Band 157 400
is only operated "by chance": take-off and landing site, Martin in the air

Level System

- Level 1 = good flying, good conditions.
- Level 2 = at the limit, but still ok.
- Level 3 = you should stop the task

Attention: Switch on tracker

- Press left, then press right.
- Switching off the tracker does not work (they are in competition mode).

- Where are the trackers handed out? At the valley station, when you get the food
- Pilots should remember the number for quick delivery. A list will be published in the chat.

GAP Factors

- 60 km, 1:30, 30%, 7 km, 95%

Landing site

- Wind conditions: Valley wind, normal is 15-30 kmh
- Cable? No

GPS Altitude / Zero Tolerance
